Consultation on change of Published Admission Number (PAN)

Dear stakeholders/local community,

We are consulting with you in line with the School Admission Code 2021.

Following discussion with the School Admissions Team, we are consulting on changing the order of the over subscription criteria to:

- 1. **Children in care and children who were previously in care** but immediately after being in care became subject to an Adoption, Child Arrangement, or Special Guardianship Order including those who appear (to the admission authority) to have been in state care outside of England and ceased to be in care as a result of being adopted (see Note 1).
- 2. Children who have a **sibling** (see Note 2) attending the chosen school at the time of application and who will still have a sibling attending the School, in Years 7 13 at the proposed date of admission.
- 3. **Children of all staff** who have been employed by the school for at least 2 years at the time at which the application for admission to the school is made, or the member of staff is recruited to fill a vacant post for which there is a demonstrable skill shortage.
- 4. Children who live in the designated area of the school, or whose parents can provide evidence that they will be living in the designated area of the school by the proposed date of admission.
- 5. Children who **attend one of the following primary schools (see policy)** on the closing date of applications as part of the Co-ordinated Admissions Scheme in the year preceding admission to a secondary school.
- 6. Distance from school with those living closer having greater priority.
